This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

2. The facts of the case are that the Applicant filed the Compensation Application (CA) on 19.01.2023 and the Office after scrutiny of the CA on 20.01.2023, intimated the defects to the Applicant on the same day and returned the CA to the Applicant on 02.02.2023. The Applicant re-filed the CA on 10.02.2023. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that the Applicant was under the bona fide belief that there were no defects and on inquiry it was known to the authorized representative that there were defects. Then there was some technical difficulty in the e-portal due to which some of the defects could not be cured and after the problem in the portal was sorted on e-portal, the filing was done. Hence, there is delay of 14 days in re-filing the CA, so the same may be condoned.

3. Heard learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant and perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report.

4. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the Applicant and for the reasons mentioned in the IA, which are sufficient, the delay in re-filing the CA is hereby condoned.

5. With the aforesaid order, this IA stands disposed of.
